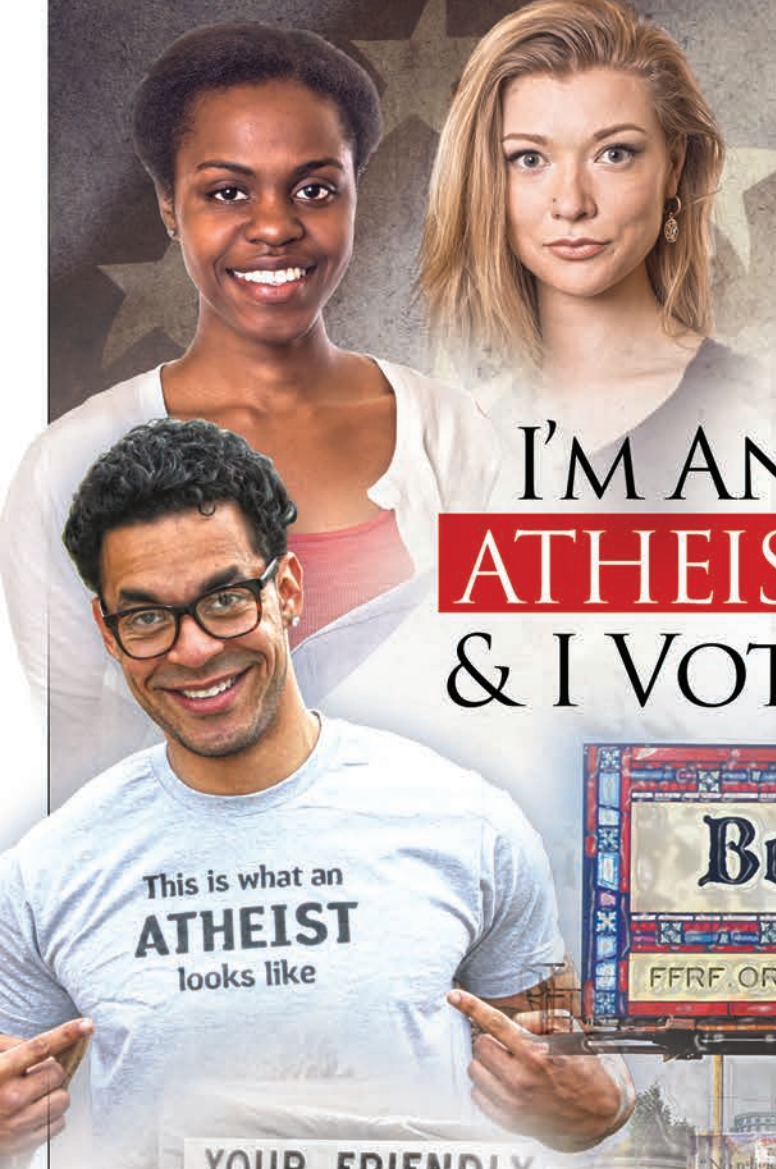

### Interrogatories Served in Gaylor vs Reagan

Lawyers for Anne Gaylor, president of the Freedom From Religion Foundation, filed interrogatories with the U.S. Federal Court in Madison, Wisconsin, this month seeking more information on government involvement in "Year of the Bible." The interrogatories will be served on President Ronald Reagan's personal secretary, Elizabeth Taylor, and the White House. The interrogatories also will be served on the White House's press secretary, Mike Miller, and the White House's chief of staff, Mark Meadows. Meadows is the only person who has seen the letter and the President's letter to the public. Gaylor asked the court to force Reagan to answer the interrogatories. "Year of the Bible" is a program of the U.S. Constitution, Article VI, Section III, which states that no religious test shall ever be required as a qualification to any office or public trust under the United States.
