Dear Mr. Drummond:

I am writing you again on behalf of the Freedom From Religion Foundation (FFRF) regarding the "Spring Tea." In a letter dated July 30, 2015, you assured us that, "Based on this entire situation, the District's central administration has decided that in order to avoid any issues in the future, the District will discontinue its involvement with the 'Spring Tea' in any way in the future." We relied on this assurance in not pursuing any legal action regarding Muskogee Public Schools' involvement with this highly religious event.

A complainant has brought to our attention that at least one school from Muskogee Public Schools participated in the "Spring Tea" again, this year.<sup>1</sup> This appears to be in direct conflict with what we were told would occur.

We ask that you please investigate this situation and respond at your earliest convenience so that we may address our complaints concerns and discuss an adequate resolution to this matter.
