STIPULATION

The plaintiffs, Freedom From Religion Foundation, Inc. ("FFRF"), Craig Gosling, John Kiel, Sean O'Brien, Diana O'Brien, and Jonathan Kraeszig, by their attorneys, Godfrey & Kahn, S.C. and the Law Office of William O. Harrington, P.C., and the defendant, E. Mitchell Roob, Jr., stipulate as follows:

- 1. The plaintiffs filed their Complaint in this action on May 2, 2007, challenging on constitutional grounds the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration's (the "FSSA")

 Chaplaincy Program (the "FSSA Chaplaincy Program"), including the hiring of Pastor Michael

 L. Latham as the Chaplain for the FSSA.
 - 2. The plaintiffs filed an Amended Complaint on July 10, 2007.

- 3. Before Mr. Roob had responded to the Amended Complaint, the FSSA terminated the Chaplaincy Program and terminated Pastor Latham's employment with the FSSA.
