Assembly Contract

This Assembly Contract is made and entered into as of January 26, 2012 by and among **Dunkerton High School in Dunkerton, IA** referred to as the "Contracting Party," and "You Can Run But You Cannot Hide International, Inc." of Annandale, Minnesota, referred to as the "Contracted Party." CONTRACTING PARTY and CONTACTED PARTY shall be referred to herein as "the parties." The parties hereby agreed that "Contracted Party" shall perform the following services for the "Contracting Party".

1.00 School Assembly Program:

1.01 Junkyard Prophet:

Junkyard Prophet is the opening part of our assembly program, including a huge light show, and fog machines, *which will be used at each school.* Voted second-best unsigned band nation wide and using the type of music your kids can relate to, the band is used as a tool to open up the heart and minds of each student to receive the message to follow. If at all possible we would like the assembly to be held in an auditorium. If we set up the day before the actual assembly, we will have a few of our crewmembers stay with the equipment for security purposes.

1.02 Assembly Program:

The student assembly is the second part of our program in which Bradlee Dean/Jake MacAulay will discuss issues such as drugs, alcoholism, suicide, sex, media, our country, our Veterans, our freedom, the Constitution, the choices we make, the friends that we have, and more in a language that speaks directly to the heart of this generation. It is an overall message of responsibility. All of our material is made public and is factual in content and in form. We have an agenda for truth and not agenda for opinion.

1.03 3 Groups - Classroom Discussions:

The classroom discussions will be held after the assembly on **March 8, 2012.** The class time is where we separate the guys from the girls, the students from the teachers (exceptions as necessary) and talk about issues pertaining to guys and girls respectively. This allows all to get involved and ask questions pertaining to the material and be a part of our program in a personal way. Boys and girls almost always open up more readily when separated, so we divided the students into classes based on gender. Each YCRBYCH representative conducting the classes are speaking based upon experience and not upon knowledge alone.

1.03 a Group 1 Boys:

The boys will be doing a huge exploration on music, dealing with different artists, what they stand for and don't stand for, their lyrics and more.

1.03 b Group 2 Girls:

The girls will deal with issues such as the beauty of being a bride, purity, your heart, knowing whom you follow and more.

1.03 c Group 3 Teachers:

The class portion for teachers will be geared towards bridging the gap between teachers and students and will equip them to lead the way in identifying and overcoming the problems and challenges the students are facing every day.

3.00 Costs: The cost of the assembly program for your school is **\$2,000.00**. As a part of this fee, \$750.00 is required up front as a non-refundable security deposit at the signing of the contract.

The balance of \$1,250.00 must be paid upon the arrival of the Contracted Party on the school campus for unloading equipment.

4.00 Program Confirmation Process: To complete the scheduling process, please perform the following:

4.00a Please fax the signed contract immediately to us at (320) 274-8438.

4.00b Enclose the original signed contract **with the deposit** and forward them to our office. (Be sure to keep a copy of the contract for your records.)

4.01 Upon the receipt of the fax we will schedule your assembly program. Upon receipt of the original contract **and deposit** we will secure that date.

4.02 The assembly date for your school is scheduled on **Thursday, March 8, 2012**.

5.00 Cancellation: Cancellation of an assembly program on or before 30 consecutive days will result in the loss of the non-refundable deposit. Cancellation within 30 consecutive days will result in either a reschedule at the discretion of the Contracted Party or the payment of the entire remaining balance. The date must be rescheduled within 14 consecutive days of the notice of cancellation or the remaining balance will be due at that time.

6.00 Warranties: We fully warrant our productions to be factual; connective with the students, encouraging and to produce an atmosphere of thought and responsibility for the student and the world they live in.

We further warrant that teachers will have great opportunity to acquire many essential tools to effectively reach students, which they can take back to the classroom. We look forward to working with you in your efforts to educate and impact the students of America for a better tomorrow.

7.00 Compliance with Law: **CONTRACTED PARTY** hereby agrees to comply with all policies, rules and regulations of **CONTRACTING PARTY** and with all applicable laws and regulations.

8.00 Notices. Any notices to be given hereunder by either party to the other may be effected either by personal delivery in writing or by mail, registered or certified, postage prepaid, with return receipt requested. Mailed notices shall be addressed to the parties at the addresses appearing in the introductory paragraph of this agreement, but each party may change the address by written notice in accordance with this paragraph. Notices delivered personally will be deemed communicated as of actual receipt; mailed notices will be deemed communicated as of three (3) days after mailing.

9.00 Assignment. Neither this agreement nor any duties or obligations under this agreement are assignable by CONTRACTED PARTY.

10.00 Effective Date: This contract shall be effective upon its signing by the Contracting Party.

11.00 Authority and Execution. Each person executing this Agreement on behalf of a party hereto represents and warrants that Mr. Mike Cooper is duly and validly authorized to do so on behalf of such party, with full right and authority to exercise this Agreement and to bind such party with respect to all of the obligations hereunder.
