Ruling held. Plaintiff has alleged that Defendant permitted posting by an anti-religion group of a printed sign, together with religious symbols posted by religious organizations. The identity of the anti-religion organization was clearly displayed, defeating any inference that the sign was somehow sponsored by Defendant. The First Amendment prohibits the content-based discrimination for which Plaintiff's complaint argues. Defendant's conduct may violate the state laws and regulations cited by Plaintiff, but his allegations do not support the conclusion that such conduct violated Plaintiff's federal constitutional rights. Defendant's motion to dismiss [11] is granted. This case is dismissed. Rule 16 conference is stricken.
